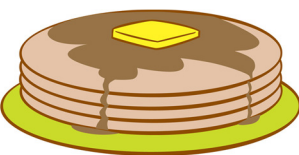

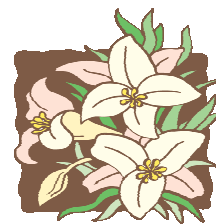
## Journey to the Cross Family Experience- FX
