Opportunities for volunteering at St. Paul

ALY: An all-volunteer program to supply supplemental packs of food for children who are at risk or facing food insecurity. St. Paul provides storage and work space. St. Paul packs and delivers during the months of November and March.

Clothes Closet: A community resource housed in the Anamosa United Methodist church. Also all-volunteer, supported by local churches. St. Paul is responsible for February and May. The closet is open on Thursdays from 9 AM until 4 PM, but volunteers can work any weekday between 9 AM and 2 PM.

HACAP: The food truck comes to Anamosa on the 3rd Thursday of the month with donated food available for anyone, with no requirements or financial guidelines. Volunteers work from 2:30 PM until 4PM, loading items into recipients' vehicles.

Quilting: Volunteers gather to tie quilts. Fabric is available for anyone who can create quilt tops at home. The finished quilts are taken to the Cedar Rapids Lutheran World Relief collection point in April and October to be shipped globally.

Worship: Volunteers are needed for ushering, greeting, power point, preparing and serving communion, making communion bread, reading scripture, leading prayers, offering musical talents for the Praise Team and Celebration Singers' choir. Changing the paraments and banners and seasonal decorating are also done by volunteers.

Funerals: Led by the Fellowship Committee, volunteers are needed to serve the families. This may include ushering, donating and serving food, organizing the dining area, and always the dishes and cleaning up.

Committees: Always looking for volunteers, committees usually have a church council member as a liaison. Some meet regularly, some only as needed. A great opportunity to have input that is very important to the St. Paul family.
